RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised by Mr. Sidney Baha of North Fork that he is only thirty (30) feet from the main waterline or sewerline and has requested Utility Authority, for over a year, to connect him to the said waterline, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Baha informs the Tribal Council that he is in urgent need of water, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been made aware by other tribal members of great need to hook up residences to the main water/sewer lines because of problems with septic tanks which are now outmoded, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the hookup of reservation tribal homes to the city sewer/water lines should be a high priority for health and welfare reasons.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Paschal Johnson, Director of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Utility Authority, to immediately hook up Mr. Sidney Baha's sewer/water lines to that of Whiteriver.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Utility Authority is hereby directed to immediately determine what tribal homes can be hooked up to the main sewer/water lines for the town of Whiteriver and to report their findings to the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe with a proposed schedule for connecting those tribal homes to the main sewer/water lines operated by Utility Authority; and further, that this report should be made to the Tribal Council through the Chairman of the Tribal Council within twenty (20) days of the date of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on July 08, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
