RESOLUTION OF THE WITTE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Chaghashe Day Care Center has approached the Tribal Council and requested \$50,000.00 in Revenue Sharing Funds in order to continue their very successful Day Care Center for working parents, and
- WHEREAS, the Chaghashe Day Care Center has demonstrated to the Tribal Council with specifics, how the proposed \$50,000.00 will be spent amongst staff and operating expenses, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council remains committed to doing whatever it can to assist working parents in the proper care of their young children.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it approves the request of the Chaghashe Day Care Center for \$50,000.00 in Revenue Sharing Funds.

The foregoing resolution was on July 08, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
