

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the General Livestock Association representing all of the livestock associations on the reservation has requested permission from the Tribal Council for the installation of Radio/Repeater stations on McKay's Peak and Maverick Mountain for a period of ten (10) years for the use of a lease between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Motorola Company which has agreed to installing the repeater stations free-of-charge, and

WHEREAS, the General Livestock Association has advised the Tribal Council that these repeater stations will greatly enhance the efficiency and communications between the livestock associations on the range and the Tribal Council agreeing with the request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of the General Livestock Association for the installation of the Radio/Repeater Stations to be installed by Motorola Company, free-of-charge on McKay's Peak and Maverick Mountain.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby grants the ten-year lease to Motorola Corporation for the repeater stations on McKay's Peak and Maverick Mountain.


The foregoing resolution was on July 08, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
