

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, Mr. Raymus Albert, has made a report to the Tribal Council regarding the selection of a new, permanent Director to administer the Housing Authority, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Albert has requested of the Tribal Council, permission to negotiate a salary of approximately \$23,000.00 per year for the position plus free housing for the Director as and when he is selected, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Albert has explained to the Tribal Council that the Commission believes that it is necessary that the Director lives on the reservation in order to properly administer the Housing Authority and that the salary of \$23,000.00 per annum and free living accommodations is necessary to offer applicants so that the very best applicant can be chosen.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby agrees that a proper incentive must be made to applicants for the position of Director of the Housing Authority in order to attract talented and skillful administrators; therefore, the request of the Commission is hereby granted.


