


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been made aware for sometime, of a situation existing in the town of McNary of increased arson, vandalism and a general deterioration caused by the neglect and possible breach of sublease provisions, duties and responsibilities of the sublessor, Galbraith Corporation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to make Galbraith comply with their responsibilities set forth in their sublease with Southwest Forest Industries and require them to clean up condemned or burnt down homes, to maintain the streets and areas and to ensure that only authorized persons are residing in McNary; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council also concludes the Southwest Forest Industries, who has the master lease for the mill town of McNary, has the responsibility also of ensuring that Galbraith Corporation lives up to their responsibilities and duties set forth in the sublease.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby demands that Galbraith Corporation immediately commence to clean up burnt and condemned homes in the town of McNary, to present a list of all persons leasing or purchasing homes or who have purchased homes and are now residing in those homes in the town of McNary to the Tribal Attorney.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs Galbraith Corporation to remove any person or persons who are not authorized to reside in the town of McNary through effective procedures after first advising the Tribal Council through the Tribal Attorney the names of persons he proposes to evict.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it expects and requests Southwest Forest Industries to enforce the provisions of the sublease against Galbraith Corporation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it instructs the Tribal Attorney to follow up this resolution and report back to the Tribal Council within thirty (30) days of the date hereof, steps taken by Galbraith Corporation and Southwest Forest Industries to fulfill their obligations and responsibilities to the town of McNary as set forth in the lease and sublease.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1982, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i, h & q) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
