## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Tribal Council has advised the Tribal Council that he has terminated Mr. Harmon Johnson from his position as Manager of the Commercial Shopping Center for a variety of reasons, including but not limited to, non-communication with the Office of the Chairman regarding the Shopping Center, lack of improvement in the Shopping Center, complaints from tribal members and inability to place the Shopping Center in a profit-making margin, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council Chairman has requested that the Tribal Council concur in his termination of Harmon Johnson as the Manager of the Commercial Shopping Center, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, by a majority vote, concurs in the termination and recommendations by the Tribal Chairman that a replacement be sought as soon as possible.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby concurs in the termination of Harmon Johnson as the Manager of the Shopping Center for the reasons stated by the Tribal Council Chairman, Ronnie Lupe.

The foregoing resolution was on July 09, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
