

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority has presented to the Tribal Council a budget for Fiscal Year 1982/1983, and

WHEREAS, after considerable discussion, the Tribal Council approves of the proposed Utility Authority Budget, and

WHEREAS, further, Paschal Johnson, Director of the Utility Authority has advised the Tribal Council that the Utility Authority are no longer being engaged in contract projects but will be completing three (3) Indian Health Service projects within thirty (30) days which has not been computed into the proposed Utility's budget for FY 82/83 which is attached to this resolution, and

WHEREAS, Paschal Johnson has advised the Tribal Council that tax and benefits under Paragraph I B Entitled, "Water and Sewer Personnel" should be 15% and further that the number of community sewer hangups for Canyon Day is not 112 but lowered to 100 and that there are no other modifications or changes in his proposed Utilities Authority Budget.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the proposed Utility Authority Budget for Fiscal Year 1982/1983 which is attached to this Resolution.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Mr. Paschal Johnson, Director of the Utility Authority is directed to further review his budget and to come before the Council if an amendment to the budget is necessary and is requested to do so within thirty (30) days of the date of this resolution.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Utility Authority Manager and Board to immediately notify its subscribers of the rate increase and the reasons comparing the rate increase by notice and explanation in the Apache Scout and if the Tribal Utility Authority Budget allows, by individual notice and explanation attached with the next billing to the subscribers.

The foregoing resolution was on August 13, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
