RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency, owns and maintains Bureau buildings on the Reservation within designated Bureau Compounds, and
- WHEREAS, presently, Bureau of Indian Affairs' Quarters No. 216 and the underlying parcel of land is located within the Theodore Roosevelt Boarding School Compound, and the Bureau desires to transfer ownership of said Quarters to the Tribe which is in extreme need of such structure.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the transfer of Bureau of Indian Affairs' Quarters No. 216 and assumes ownership and possession for the Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents as may be necessary to effectuate said transfer.

The foregoing resolution was on September 08, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
