## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is committed to the delivery of quality mental health services for its tribal members, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is in need of the continuation of such services as have been provided by the Apache Tribal Guidance Center, and

WHEREAS, the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act (P-L, 93-638) provides for the Department of Health and Human Services, through the U.S. Indian Health Service, to enter into contract with tribes to provide such services.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby request from the Phoenix Area Indian Health Services Office a Contract beginning on October 01, 1982 through June 30, 1983 providing for four (4) staff positions and operational costs for the provision of Mental Health Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount of the request is \$77,631.00.

The foregoing resolution was on September 08, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
