## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has taken a heed of the necessity to cut the Tribal Budget and to save money wherever possible for the benefit of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that it should cut expenses not only in the area of the Central Budget and the Tribal Enterprises, but also in the area of Tribal Council per diem, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council members presently receive \$75.00 per diem while in session, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council in the interest of budget restratint and inorder to set a proper example, feel it is wise to reduce their per diem to the sum of \$50.00 per day until the economy allows it to be restored to the present received \$75.00 per day.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that effective September 21, 1982, the Tribal Council per diem shall be reduced from \$75.00 per day to \$50.00 per day and shall remain at \$50.00 per day until such time as the tribal economy permits a restoration of the per diem rate to \$75.00 per day.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council taht this action by the Tribal Council has been initiated as an example to Tribal Enterprises and tribal employees that budgetary restraint is necessary in all departments until such time as the national and tribal economy revives and become once again prosperous.

The foregoing resolution was on September 21, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
