

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Vice-Chairman, Reno Johnson, of the Tribal Council has requested permission from the Tribal Council to sell the former Vice-Chairman's office car, a 1979 Ford LTD, in light of the fact that the tribe has purchased a new office car for the Vice-Chairman and the Ford LTD is no longer necessary to keep and maintain, and

WHEREAS, the Vice-Chairman has advised the Tribal Council that a member of his staff has expressed an interest in purchasing the 1979 Ford LTD and

WHEREAS, the Vice-Chairman further advised the Tribal Council that he will obtain an appraisal from a Ford dealership as to the value of the car and will rely on said appraisal in order to set a ceiling price for the car, and

WHEREAS, the Vice-Chairman has obtained an appraisal of the 1979 Ford LTD from McSpadden Ford, Inc. which is attached and incorporated by reference to this resolution, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the Vice-Chairman's suggestion that the car be sold at the appraised value.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the Vice Chairman to obtain an appraisal value for the 1979 Ford LTD, the former Vice-Chairman's office car at the appraised value.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Vice-Chairman's request that a member of his staff be permitted the opportunity of first right of refusal to purchase the 1979 Ford LTD at the appraised value.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in any event that a member of the Vice-Chairman's staff refuses to purchase the said vehicle that the Vice-Chairman is granted permission to sell said vehicle to the next interested party at the appraised value.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proceeds of any such sale of the 1979 Ford LTD be remitted to Mr. Don Booker, Tribal Administrator.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
