RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Minor Kinney, has come before the Tribal Council and with him, Vincent Altaha, Sr., for purposes of requesting that the Tribal Council reinstate him to his old position from which he was suspended almost two years ago pending an investigation as to mismanagement of funds at the Tribal Super Market, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Kinney advises the Tribal Council that his present job in Pinetop has terminated and that he has great family responsibilities and financial obligations and is in dire need of immediate employment, and
- WHEREAS, he further advises the Tribal Council that he cannot even receive unemployment compensation because, officially, he was never terminated from the tribal payroll, but was only suspended indefinitely pending the outcome of the investigation, and
- WHEREAS, he has no idea how long the investigation will take before his name is cleared and cannot wait to feed his family until the investigation is completed, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is moved by Mr. Kinney's appeal and by the financial needs of him and his family and further agrees that the Tribal Council should do everything it can to locate a job for Mr. Kinney.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that a copy of this resolution be delivered to all the Enterprise Managers and Tribal Personnel Office for the purpose enlisting their assistance to locate Minor Kinney suitable employment.

The foregoing resolution was on November 09, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
