

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a tribal member, Edward Walker, has come before the Tribal Council requesting that the Tribal Council obtain financial assistance for him so that he can have a home built for him as soon as possible in Canyon Day, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes there may be funds available through the Home Improvement Program and that Mr. Walker's request is worthy of consideration and the Tribal Council, having been satisfied that Mr. Walker has a need for a home at Canyon Day and that it hereby request the Director of the Home Improvement Program (HIP) to do everything possible to construct a home for Mr. Edward Walker at Canyon Day under the Home Improvement Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it request the Director of the Home Improvement Program to report back to the Tribal Council within thirty (30) days of this resolution as to the status of Mr. Edward Walker's application for a home through the Home Improvement Program.

The foregoing resolution was on November 09, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
