## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, on this date, Tribal member, Addie Cromwell has come before the Tribal Council and requested that the Tribal Council assist her in her attempts to have her home remodeled at Canyon Day for the purposes of adding a room and to use the home before the winter because her home is in dire need of remodelling and weatherization, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after some discussion, endorsed that Addie Cromwell's request is worthy and that her request should be given priority at this time, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Billy Kane, Director of Human Resources Center can satisfy Addie Cromwell's request through funds available to the Weatherization Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Billy Kane, Director of the Human Resources Center, to contact Addie Cromwell of Canyon Day for details as to her needs and to give her request for remodelling and weatherization of her house, priority.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Director Billy Kane is requested to report to the Chairman of the Tribal Council within thirty (30) days of the receipt of this resolution, status of Addie Cromwell's request to remodel and weatherize her home.

The foregoing resolution was on November 09, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
