

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilman Alvino Hawkins, who has been employed with the Tribal Roads Department prior to its dissolution, advises the Tribal Council that approximately \$29,000.00 worth of heavy equipment and earth-moving labor performed by the Tribal Roads Department for Lufkin Construction Company, the contractors for Segment I of the Whiteriver Waste Water Treatment Project, remains unpaid by Lufkin, and

WHEREAS, monies have been retained by the Tribe pursuant to the contract with Lufkin Construction Company which can cover the amount due and owing to the Tribal Roads Department, and

WHEREAS, it is requested that the former Tribal Roads Department Manager, Rudy Walker, and Alvino Hawkins document the \$29,000.00 that is due and owing to the Tribal Roads Department by Lufkin Construction Company.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Business Administrator, Mr. Don Booker, to withhold from payment to Lufkin Construction Company the sum of \$29,000.00, as and for work performed by the Tribal Roads Department for Lufkin Construction Company during construction of the Whiteriver Waste Water Treatment Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs Rudy Walker and Alvino Hawkins to present to Don Booker, Administrative Manager, documentation and proof of the \$29,000.00 sum detailing the hours worked, salaries paid and equipment costs, so that the Administrative Manager can properly demand payment from Lufkin Construction Company and withhold monies due Lufkin Construction Company in order to satisfy said debt.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this billing documentation should be completed and presented to the Administrative Manager within five (5) days of the receipt of this resolution by Mr. Hawkins and Mr. Walker.

The foregoing resolution was on November 09, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
