

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a tentative agreement between the Whiteriver Police Department (WRPD) and Northland Pioneer College (NPC) in respect to co-sponsoring an upcoming Police Academy Training Program, and

WHEREAS, under the agreement Northland Pioneer College would provide the following to the Academy:

1. All printing services (Estimated cost, \$200.00)
2. Instructional supplies (pencils, pens, etc.)
3. All audio-visual support equipment.
4. Pay the Police Department \$2,907.00 for Instructor costs associated expenses,

and

WHEREAS, the Whiteriver Police Department would provide the following:


1. Dates and schedules for the training.
2. Classrooms and inhouse materials.
3. Recruiting of students.
4. Maintain standards of curriculum to meet requirements of the Arizona Law Enforcement Officers Advisory Council.
5. Receive enrollment fees from outside students and remit \$50.00 per student to Northland Pioneer College.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the agreement between the Whiteriver Police Department and Northland Pioneer College to co-sponsor the Police Academy Training; PROVIDED, that said operation shall be self-supporting, without impact upon the Whiteriver Police Department operating budget beyond the \$50.00 registration fee for each Whiteriver Police Department enrollee.

The foregoing resolution was on November 09, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
