RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Annie (Duryea) Ethelbah, a tribal member and a Senior Citizen, has come before the Tribal Council with a request that the Council provide her with a comfortable, decent dwelling as she is in dire need of a house, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that her request is justified and that the Home Improvement Program should provide her with a comfortable home.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Home Improvement Program to evaluate their list of persons according to the greatest need and do all that is possible with available funding to provide a home for Mrs. Annie (Duryea) Ethelbah.

The foregoing resolution was on November 01, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
