RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Billy Kane, Director of the White Mountain Apache Human Service Center, the organizational unit responsible for the development and the administration of the Tribe's Social Service Programs, has presented a report to the Tribal Council in regards to the philosophy and purpose and goals of the Human Service Center, the names of the Advisory Committee on the Social Service evaluation conducted through a 638 grant as well as a general report regarding custodial care program carry-over funds and a review of the Public Law 93-638 proposal for a Social Service evaluation and planning addendum to the project proposal, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Billy Kane presented considerable detail on each of these programs, proposals, and purposes and goals of the Human Service Center which was well-received by the Tribal Council and for which the Tribal Council hereby acknowledge its appreciation, and
- WHEREAS, a copy of the draft mission statement, Social Service evaluation Advisory Committee designees and documents pertaining to custodial care carry-over funds and 638 proposal for a Social Service evaluation which were distributed by Mr. Kane are attached to this resolution.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby approves the draft mission statement
 presented by Billy Kane as Director of the White Mountain
 Apache Human Service Center.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it approves the designated Advisory Committee on the Social Service evaluation, the names of whom are attached hereto.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby acknowledges receipt of documents pertaining to appropriate carry-over funds and the 638 proposal for an evaluation of Social Service and Planning Projects for the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
