RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company employees have voluntarily deducted money from their paychecks for the purposes of making a donation to the West Anderson, Sr. family in order to assist them in rebuilding a planned convenient store, which, unfortunately burned to the ground several weeks ago, causing a great financial loss to the Anderson family, and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire and wish of the Fort Apache Timber Company employees that the West Anderson, Sr. family receive these monies to help them rebuild the store and to help their financial loss, and
- WHEREAS, prior Tribal Council resolution prohibited payroll deductions for purposes of assigning wages for payment to another, and
- WHEREAS, the Manager of the Fort Apache Timber Company will not tender the collected donations to the West Anderson family without Tribal Council approval, and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council concludes that an exception should be made in this case as the monies collected represent donations for a humanitarian and charitable cause.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby directs the management of the Fort
 Apache Timber Company to immediately deliver to the
 West Anderson, Sr. family, the donations collected by
 the Fort Apache Timber Company employees for that purpose.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that with the exception of this donation, prior resolutions prohibiting assignment of wages or payment to another person shall remain in full force and effect and that any exceptions must be presented to the Tribal Council on a case by case basis as in the West Anderson situation.

The foregoing resolution was on January 13, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
