

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service Officer, DeVore Thompson, has recommended that Resolution No. 68-23 be amended to eliminate physical for food handlers, but to require them to obtain health cards form Indian Health Service, and

WHEREAS, said proposed amendments would provide as follows:

- (1) that Resolution No. 68-23 be amended by providing that a Food Service Health Card from the Indian Health Service be issued to all food handlers as a requirement for employment as a food handler;
- (2) that said care may be revoked by an Indian Health Service Health Officer, upon receipt of evidence by the Health Officer indicating repeated or continuing violations of accepted procedures and practices in the preparation service or storage of food or beverages offered for public consumption; and
- (3) that Resolution No. 68-23 requirement that food handlers receive a physical prior to employment as a food handler be eliminated,

and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council declares that any provision of Resolution No. 68-23 that conflicts with this resolution is hereby repealed and revoked, but that all other provisions set forth in Resolution No. 68-23 not specifically revoked herein by this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby amends Resolution No. 68-23 as follows:

- (1) that Resolution No. 68-23 be amended by providing that a Food Service Health Card from the Indian Health Service be issued to all food handlers as a requirement for employment as a food handler;
- (2) that said card may be revoked by an Indian Health Service Health Officer, upon receipt of evidence by the Health Officer indicating repeated or continuing violations of accepted procedures and practices in the preparation service or storage of food or beverages offered for public consumption; and

- (3) that Resolution No. 68-23 requirement that food handlers receive a physical prior to employment as a food handler be eliminated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that a copy of this resolution shall be delivered forthwith to the Indian Health Service with a request that said resolution be distributed by the Indian Health Service to all food handlers on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that this resolution shall become effective immediately and that full compliance with the requirements of said resolution shall be expected upon distributions of this resolution to all food handler by the Indian Health Service.


