

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has authorized the formation of a Volunteer Fire Department in the McNary - Hondah area, and

WHEREAS, the existing equipment does not provide for the personnel safety of the members of the fire department, and

WHEREAS, there are serious deficiencies in the firefighting equipment available to the fire department.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Housing Authority to provide to the fire department, as funds from the townsite fees and tenants income becomes available, the following equipment:


