

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, under Federal laws the recipients of Federal funding (grant or contract) are permitted to establish a valid Indirect Cost Rate (ICR) the purpose of which is to cover the costs of administering the respective Federal Grants and Contracts, and
- WHEREAS, the Office of Audits and Investigations of the Department of the Interior has established and revised annually an Indirect Cost Rate for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, which Indirect Cost Rate is authorized to be applied to Federal and State Grant/Contract Programs, and
- WHEREAS, the annual revision of the Tribal Indirect Cost Rate for Federal FY 1983 increased the rate from 4.5% (of grant/contract funds) to 13.1% effective October 01, 1982; said increase to be applicable to all Federally/State funded programs on-Reservation for FY 1983, and
- WHEREAS, in order for the Indirect Cost Rate increase to become effective it is necessary for the program managers to initiate modifications to the grant/contract budgets, retroactive to October 01, 1982, and
- WHEREAS, the rapidly increasing volume of grants and contracts administered by the White Mountain Apache Tribe requires a substantial increase in staff and other administrative costs in order to provide effective service to the various programs; said costs to be covered by Indirect Cost Rate funds provided by the grant/contract programs.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that all Federally/State-funded program directors take the following actions (retroactive to October 01, 1982):
1. Immediately initiate a modification to the respective budgets to incorporate the increase from 4.5% to 13.1% - if the 4.5% Indirect Cost Rate is already in effect; or
 2. Initiate a modification to incorporate the 13.1% Indirect Cost Rate if no Indirect Cost Rate is presently in the budget; or
 3. Submit to the Administrative Manager a memorandum outlining in detail the reasons if 1. or 2. above cannot be accomplished.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in those cases where doubt exists as to the applicability of Indirect Cost Rate to any particular program (s), the program manager initiate inquiries to the top levels of the controlling agency (ies) to obtain specific answers to the Indirect Cost Rate question; said answers to be communicated to the Administrative Manager in writing.

The foregoing resolution was on February 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
