

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, numerous requests have been received from Tribal Departments and programs for Revenue Sharing funds to support or supplement important activities, and

WHEREAS, the limited Revenue Sharing funds available to the Tribe allow only a small percentage of worthy programs to be funded, and

WHEREAS, it is the Tribal Policy to evaluate competing requirements for Revenue Sharing funds on the basis of one or more of the following criteria:

1. Does the program have a direct impact on public health and/or safety?
2. Can the program locate other available and timely funding sources?
3. Does the program have follow-on funds to continue operations after Revenue Sharing funds are used?
4. Does the proposed contribute substantially to improving Tribal organizational and/or management capabilities?, and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has reviewed numerous requests for use of Revenue Sharing funds and has evaluated the following projects under the above criteria:

1. Alcoholism Program:
Completion of new addition to Women's Quarters\$ 1,500.00
 2. Health Authority:
Two passenger vans - patient transportation.....\$21,246.00
 3. Juvenile Court:
Construction of Judge's bench in Juvenile Court Room.....\$ 1,500.00
 4. Youth Service Center:
Furnishings, appliances, vehicle..\$14,000.00
 5. Tribal Attorney:
Completion of Tribal Code.....\$40,000.00
 6. Carrizo/Cedar Creek Communities:
TV relay, Community Building improvements, cattle guard..... \$20,000.00
