

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Bureau of Indian Affairs' appropriation for Fiscal Year 1983 has been passed and signed into law, and

WHEREAS, a line item in said appropriation provides for Extension Services, and

WHEREAS, such funding amount is tentatively identified as being \$50,000.00, and

WHEREAS, there exist an urgent need for a veterinary program to address the prevention and treatment of diseases and injuries to animals, and

WHEREAS, an educational program component is needed to disseminate information to the livestock association, individual livestock owners, and pet owners pertaining to the health and care of animals and the public health of the general public, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council can provide the necessary personnel and develop a viable program and provide program oversight.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it requests from the Fort Apache Indian Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs, a P. L. 93-638 contract to provide veterinary services and educational programs for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said contract shall commence in Fiscal Year 1983 and continue thereafter until the program/contract is terminated by the Tribal Council. The program will be administered by/and in accordance with the contract proposal.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Chairman or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate the contract and any amendments thereto and to execute all the necessary contract documents and any amendment thereof necessary.

The foregoing resolution was on February 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
