RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribe has encouraged individual members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enter into business,
- WHEREAS, Adam and Charlene Lupe are interested in purchasing the East Fork Trading Post, and
- WHEREAS, Jerome H. Hartnett, the owner of the East Fork Trading Post, agrees and consents to the purchase and transfer of the business to Adam and Charlene Lupe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a new twenty-five (25) year lease with Adam and Charlene Lupe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the terms and conditions of the lease shall be in accordance with Ordinance No. 90 and Tribal Resolution No. 76-88 and other resolutions that pertain to business leases with members of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
