

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Bobbie (Nachu) Stover (Mrs. Harry Stover, Jr.) came before the Tribal Council requesting permission to sponsor a Sunrise Ceremonial dance for her daughter, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Stover further advised that this dance will be held in North Fork Community, across the highway and west of the highway from Paul Ethelbah's residence, and

WHEREAS, the dance was scheduled for the weekend of August 6 & 7, 1983.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. & Mrs. Harry Stover, Jr. are hereby given permission to hold a Sunrise Ceremonial Dance for their daughter on the weekend of August 6 & 7, 1983 at North Fork.

The foregoing resolution was on March 02, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
