

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Revocable Permits covering the McNary Lutheran Mission, Canyon Day Mission, Cedar Creek Lutheran Mission and the East Fork Mission expired on September 30, 1982, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to renew these permits and keep the missions established.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency are hereby authorized and directed to issue ten-year revocable permits pursuant to and on the same terms and conditions as the previous permits.

The foregoing resolution was on March 02, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
