

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Edna (Toggie) Bush, an elder and Senior Citizen and a member of the Tribe, is in dire need of a suitable house for herself, and

WHEREAS, according to a letter to the Tribal Council from the Service Unit Director of Indian Health Service, Mrs. Bush is seriously ill and needs adequate and safe housing immediately, and

WHEREAS, it is further recommended by the Indian Health Service Unit Director that Mrs. Bush be provided a house with bathroom and plumbing facilities due to the nature of her illness that require daily attention and care, and

WHEREAS, it was further recommended that due to her medical problem, that housing is recommended in the immediate vicinity of her family in the East Fork Community, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware and agrees that Mrs. Bush's request be considered as a priority because of her health needs and handled immediately, and

WHEREAS, that Mrs. Bush be placed on the priority listing to replace the late Ozzie Ethelbah under the Home Improvement Program or any other available housing program, and

WHEREAS, it possible, Mrs. Bush be allowed to live in one of the Elderly Rental Units while her house is remodeled and renovated for her needs.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves immediate housing for Mrs. Edna (Toggie) Bush in the East Fork Community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mrs. Bush replaced Ozzie Ethelbah, deceased, on the priority listing for housing under the Home Improvement Program or any other available program.

The foregoing resolution was on March 02, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 2 abst.7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
