RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

SEPARATION OF

AGRICULTURAL ENTERPRISE AND FARM CO-OP

- WHEREAS, Dan Trancole, Manager of the White Mountain Apache Agricultural Enterprise, has advised the Tribal Council that he has met and discussed the matter of the separation of the Agricultural Enterprise from the Farm Co-op Enterprise with Justin Williams, the Manager of the Farm Co-op Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, presently, the Farm Co-op Program is merged with and under the Agricultural Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, the purposes of the Agricultural Enterprise is large scale farming geared toward a commercial profit whereby the Farm Co-op program has as its purpose the providing of a service to Tribal Members and their family farming plots; and
- WHEREAS, all parties are in agreement that the two enterprises should be separate and under separate management.
- BE IT RESOLVED BY the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby agrees to the separation of the Agricultural Enterprise from that of the Farm Co-op Program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby reconfirms Dan Trancole as the Manager of the Agricultural Enterprise and Justin Williams as the Manager of the Farm Co-op Program.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
