

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is presently applying for EPA Funding of the White Mountain Apache Waste-water Management System, a centralized sewage collection system and treatment plant designed to serve the central communities of the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the grant guidelines of the EPA require that the Tribe as grantee, shall enact a Tribal Sewer Use Ordinance (with associated user charges) designed to assure the future successful operation and maintenance of the system, the said ordinance to be enacted and the user charge system implemented before the treatment works is placed in operation, and

WHEREAS, there is attached to this resolution, and made a part hereof by reference, a Sewer Use Ordinance and User Charge System based upon the requirements for an operating system on the White Mountain Apache Reservation, said ordinance requiring that users of the system (including commercial, industrial, educational and governmental establishments) be charged a fair and equitable fee for the use of the system.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby adopts the attached Sewer Use Ordinance and User Charge System.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this proposed sewer use ordinance be posted for a period of ten (10) days as required by the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that after this proposed ordinance has been posted for the requisite ten (10) days and if no objections are made to its passage or comments made to modify said proposed ordinance to Tribal Council Members, that said final passage may be accomplished by a walk-through resolution as an emergency measure for the health and welfare of the people.

The foregoing resolution was on March 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
