## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, representatives of the White Mountain Apache Headstart Program have come before the Tribal Council with a request that the Tribal Council approve the Annual Headstart Rodeo for April 29, 1983 thru May 01, 1983, to be held at the new Rodeo Grounds in Whiteriver, and
- WHEREAS, the Annual Headstart Rodeo is for the purpose of raising money to benefit children who are enrolled in the Headstart Program, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there is no schedule in conflict for the use of the Rodeo Grounds during the time period requested by the Headstart Program, and
- WHEREAS, the Headstart Rodeo has always proven to be extremely beneficial to the tribal children enrolled in the Headstart Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
  Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the White Mountain
  Apache Headstart Program to hold their Annual Rodeo on
  April 29, 1983 thru May 01, 1983 at the new Rodeo Grounds
  in Whiteriver.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby reaffirms its support and praise for the White Mountain Apache Headstart Program and urges all members of the tribe and public to attend the rodeo and support a very worthy program.

The foregoing resolution was on March 15, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
