

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Fort Apache Agency Superintendent discussed the FY 85 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budget in the context of the Bureau's budgetary process, and

WHEREAS, they also discussed the current budget situation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that large Automatic Data Processing charges are being assessed against the local FY 83 Budget to which it objects, and

WHEREAS, Congress has reduced the FY 83 Self-Determination Services Budget, the only program that could aid in the transfer of Federal program operation to tribal operation; thereby, resulting in a setback to Tribal Self-Determination contrary to the President's Policy and that of Public Law 93-638.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it approves the FY 85 budget as discussed and attached, and authorizes the Tribal Chairman to sign the necessary budget documents.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council strongly objects to the arbitrary and capricious violation of the budgetary process by such actions as the sudden assessment of staggering Automatic Data Processing charges against the local FY 83 budget, and Congress' reduction in the FY 83 Self-Determination Services budget, the sole program that could aid in the transfer of federal program operation to tribal operation.


The foregoing resolution was on March 24, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
