

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is presently faced with a problem that involves comfortable, decent dwellings for the elderly and Senior Citizens, who are members of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, because there are no precedures, guidelines, files or information immediately available on the progress of construction, completion dates or occupancy, it is continuing to be a problem, and

WHEREAS, Reno Johnson, Sr., Vice-Chairman volunteered to set up procedures and guidelines in his office to coordinate followup files of applicants selected by the Tribal Council from this particular group of tribal members, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Johnson would also work very closely with the Directors of the Home Improvement Program, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Tribal Work Experience Program, Weatherization Program and Save the Children Federation Program in assisting the applicants, and


WHEREAS, Mr. Johnson would consolidate all the information gathered from the Directors on a monthly basis and report to the Tribal Council of the progress, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe concur and agree that this might help alleviate some of the problems and would expedite assisting the people.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the Vice-Chairman to coordinate the data and information to better serve tribal members in need of housing under these programs for the destitute.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that cooperation of the Directors of the Home Improvement Program, Tribal Work Experience Program, Weatherization Program and Save the Children Federation Program is encouraged and solicited for this much-needed information on housing for our tribal members.

The foregoing resolution was on March 02, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
