

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Georgina H. Declay, social worker from the Indian Health Service, has requested that the Tribal Council reinstate the home application of the late Osie Ethelbah under the Home Improvement Program acting on behalf of Rosa Ethelbah, daughter of the late Osie Ethelbah; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Rosa Ethelbah's request through the good offices of Mrs. Georgina Declay is worthy and that Rosa Ethelbah should be reinstated on the list of eligible persons for the Home Improvement Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Rosa Ethelbah's name be placed on the list of eligible persons to receive an addition under the Home Improvement Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it requests that H.I.P. construct additional rooms for Rosa Ethelbah as she has requested.

The foregoing resolution was on April 6, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


