RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Human Service Center Director has previously submitted a proposal to the Tribal Council for the sum of \$20,249.00 to be obtained from the Revenue Sharing Funds; and
- WHEREAS, guidelines for the use of the Revenue Sharing Funds requires three public meetings prior to their appropriation for the use of the proposed; and
- WHEREAS, on two previous public meetings, no objections were made to the use of the Revenue Sharing Funds for the purposes proposed by the Human Service Center Director, namely for a Tribal Social Service Evaluation and Planning Project for personnel salaries, fringe benefits, and for related non-personnel related costs; and
- WHEREAS, this being the last and final public meeting requires the Revenue Sharing Funds guidelines and no objections being made to the use of the Revenue Sharing Funds for the above-described purposes.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$20,249.00 of the Revenue Sharing Funds be appropriated to the Tribal Social Service Evaluation and Planning Project for personnel salaries, fringe benefits, and for related non-personnel related cost.

The foregoing resolution was on April 6, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
