RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Grasshopper Field School Lease

- WHEREAS, by Tribal Resolution 82-287, dated December 8, 1982, a renewal of the lease for the University of Arizona Archaeological Field School at Grasshopper was granted; and
- WHEREAS, the resolution restricted the research activity to the Grasshopper Ruin; and
- WHEREAS, specifically, the research activity was restricted to a five acre lease area which pertains to the area of the field camp but not to the area of the Grasshopper Ruin which covers approximately 30 acres adjacent to the field camp; and
- WHEREAS, in the past the lease agreement with the White Mountain Apache Tribe pertained only to the field camp; and
- WHEREAS, the area of research activity and other stipulations pertinent to the management of cultural resources were covered in the Federal Antiquities permits which has not yet come before the Council; and
- WHEREAS, it has become apparent to the Tribal Council that Tribal Resolution No. 82-287 should be amended to delete the five acre restriction contained in the lease and the resolution; and
- WHEREAS, the lease for the field school is only for the living quarters for the research team and no digging takes place in that area and therefore, any language regarding restriction on digging is inappropriate; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware that the Antiquities Permit which actually governs the area upon which the research team can dig and conduct research is not yet up for renewal and that any restrictions on digging can be dealt with at the time the Antiquities Permit terminates and a renewal sought by the University of Arizona Archaeological Field School.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that paragraph 15 entitled excavation which reads, "The lessee agrees that all digging activities and research conducted by the University of Arizona shall be restricted to the five acres covered by this lease." is hereby deleted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other paragraphs in said lease for the Field School for campsite shall remain in full force and affect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be delivered to Professor J. Jefferson Reid, Associate Professor, at the University of Arizona, Department of Anthropology.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Tribal Council to execute all amendments to the afore-described lease for the Field School necessary to carry out the purposes and intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 06, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h, g & u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
