RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Keno Kane, Director of the Alcohol Detox Program for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, has requested that the Tribal Council designate the week of June 19, 1983 through June 26, 1983 as Alcohol Awareness Week so as to dramatize and bring to the attention of the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the social causes, treatment, and resolution of the problems of alcohol and alcoholism on the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, further, Mr. Keno Kane requests that a basketball tournament and rodeo be authorized by the Tribal Council in order to raise money for the center and to further highten public awareness of Alcohol Awareness Week; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that there is a conflict with rodeo schedules with the East Fork Community which is holding a rodeo during that week and therefore, a conflict exists; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the basketball tournament shall be held to dramatize and publicize to the people Alcohol Awareness Week but that the rodeo cannot be authorized because of a conflict.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby designates the week of June 19, 1983 through June 26, 1983 as Alcohol Awareness Week.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it declares that a basketball tournament be held during Alcohol Awareness Week to dramatize the purpose and intent of Alcohol Awareness Week and to further the work of the Alcohol Detox Center.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that because of the conflict with the East Fork Community which also has previously planned a rodeo for that week, it is not possible to authorize a rodeo but invites the Detox Center to utilize their creativity and initiative to come up with other ideas for fund raising for Alcohol Awareness Week.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it commends Mr. Keno Kane for bringing this to the attention of the Tribal Council and the Tribal Council endorses the purposes and intent of Alcohol Awareness Week and expresses its gratitude for Mr. Keno Kane for his work in resolving this social problem.
- The foregoing resolution was on April 7, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of $\frac{10}{10}$ for and $\frac{0}{10}$ against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
