- WHEREAS, Ms. Beatty and Mr. Hawkins have submitted for Tribal Council review, a written combined budget summary which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as well as the Health Programs Organization Chart; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Health Authority
  Budget should be approved as presented by Ms. Hedy Beatty and
  Mr. Alvino Hawkins and thanks them for an excellent presentation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the FY 1933-84 Tribal Health Authority Budget which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it commends the excellent presentation of Ms. Hedy Beatty, with an expression of thanks to Councilman Alvino Hawkins for his assistance.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that a copy of this resolution be delivered to the Director of the Tribal Health Authority and Don Booker, Administrative Manager of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on April 07, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i,b & u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
