

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


Rodeo Schedule 1983

- WHEREAS, a rodeo schedule has been submitted for review by the Tribal Council for the 1983 rodeo season; and
- WHEREAS, after some discussion with the Tribal Council, all conflicts, if any, have been discussed identified and resolved; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council receiving no objection regarding the proposed rodeo schedule for 1983 for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and concluding that said rodeo schedule should be adopted by the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the rodeo schedule attached and incorporated by reference herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that the official rodeo schedule be posted in conspicuous places and be mailed to all appropriate rodeo sponsors.

The foregoing resolution was on April 07, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
