RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, under provisions of the Tribal Constitution and Federal regulations, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is required to operate under an approved Tribal Budget, and
- WHEREAS, on this current date (April 29, 1983) the Tribal Budget for Fiscal Year 1983/84 is still under review pending final action by the Tribal Council and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the continuation of the Fiscal Year 1982/83 Budget (prorated monthly on a 1/12th basis) until final approval of the Fiscal Year 1983/84 operational budgets of the Central Tribe (01 Account) and the Tribal Enterprises by the Tribal Council and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any under-payments to Tribal employees resulting from this continuation resolution shall be payable retroactive to May 1, 1983, upon final approval of the Fiscal Year 1983/84 Tribal Budget as outlined above.

The foregoing resolution was on April 29, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
