## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member, Paschal Johnson, Sr. tas requested authorization from the Tribal Council for the removal of 200,000 cubic yards of cinders from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation cinder pit (s), and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Johnson advises the Tribal Council that this is a personal request on his part for his personal business off the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves of his request and instructs him to meet with Bureau of Indian Affairs Roads Department Officer, Bill Amos, regarding appropriate royalty rates and permits.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of Lr. Paschal Johnson for permission to remove 200,000 cubic yards of cinders from reservation cinder pit(s).
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it instructs Mr. Johnson to meet with Bill Amos, Chief of the Bureau of Indian Affairs Roads Department regarding appropriate royalty rates and digging permits prior to commencing to remove any cinders.

The foregoing resolution was on May 04, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
