


RESOLUTION OF THE


WHEREAS, Mr. & Mrs. Polk have requested that they would like the weekend of September 2 & 3, 1983 during the Tribal Fair.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that permission is hereby granted Mr. & Mrs. Elgin Polk to hold a Sunrise Ceremonial Dance for their daughter during the Tribal Fair weekend of September 2 & 3, 1983.

The foregoing resolution was on May 05, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
