FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was approached by a representative in behalf of Ms. Maxine Bush, for permission for a Tribal Ceremonial Dance, and


WHEREAS, Ms. Maxine Bush would like to sponsor a Sunrise Ceremonial Dance for her daughter during the weekend of July 23 and 24, 1983 in the East Fork Community, and

WHEREAS, Ms Bush will go in partnership on the above weekend with the Agnes and Rupert Thompson family as agreed and planned.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that permission is hereby granted to Ms. Maxine Bush to hold a Sunrise Ceremonial Dance for her daughter at East Fork on the weekend of July 23 and 24, 1983.

The foregoing resolution was on May 05, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
