

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Spruce Bark Beetle infestation on the reservation is at epidemic levels and is a threat to spruce trees in the Sunrise Ski Complex, and

WHEREAS, these live trees are necessary to protect the runs from soil erosion, wind scouring of snow and to shade the runs from the sun, and


WHEREAS, Carbaryl insecticide was used on the Sunrise area in 1982 with favorable results.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Bureau of Indian Affairs to proceed to use Carbaryl insecticide in the Sunrise Ski Complex area per Environmental Protection Agency and U. S. Fish & Wildlife guidelines if funds are available.

The foregoing resolution was on June 01, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
