

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the following logging units are contracted to the Fort Apache Timber Company, a wholly owned Tribal Enterprise:

WHEREAS, logging contracts and the Standard Provisions specifies the felling of unmerchantable dead trees within the area of cutover which are 14 inches or more in diameter and 16 feet or more in total height, and

WHEREAS, there is an advantage to the Tribe and the Purchaser not to fall unmerchantable dead trees, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Fort Apache Timber Company have agreed to fell unmerchantable trees only if occurring in special use areas or presenting a hazard in the purchaser's work area as designated by the Officer-in-Charge.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby consents to the modification of the above-mentioned logging unit contracts snag felling section; and that only unmerchantable dead trees as designated by the Officer-in-Charge will be felled. Felling of such snags will be in special use areas, such as high use recreational areas or those which present a safety hazard in the purchaser's work area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman has the authority to execute, on behalf of the Tribal Council, any and all papers pertinent to this modification.

The foregoing resolution was on June 01, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
