

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised by the Chairman that there is a present need for a viable Tribal Queen Committee due to past misunderstandings and factionalism which caused the former Tribal Queen Committee to suffer, as well as, the Tribal Queen herself in carrying out her duties, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman recommends that Ms. Marilyn Antonio, an interested person, be given authority by the Tribal Council to proceed with organizing and establishing a new Tribal Queen Committee as soon as possible so as to restore integrity and community spirit to the Tribal Queen Pageant, and so as to encourage the confidence of the tribal people and especially that of young women who wish to compete, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussing the need for a new Tribal Queen Committee, agrees with the Chairman that one should be organized and established immediately so as to reconcile misunderstandings that occurred in the past and to establish a new committee for the benefit of the people.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Ms. Marilyn Antonio, an interested party, to proceed immediately with organizing and establishing a new Tribal Queen Committee for the purposes described above.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby expresses its gratitude to Ms. Marilyn Antonio for volunteering to commit her time and effort to organizing a new Tribal Queen Committee and request that all persons who she contacts cooperate with her for the benefit of the young women who will be candidates for the new Tribal Queen and those who will serve on the Tribal Queen Committee.


The foregoing resolution was on June 01, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
