RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is presently applying for EPA funding of Segment II of the White Mountain Apache Wastewater Management System, a centralized sewage collection system and treatment plant designed to serve the central communities of the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has passed Resolution No. 83-78 adopting a Sewer Use Ordinance with associated user charges, and
- WHEREAS, due to probable delays in the completion of the East Fork-Seven Mile segment of the Wastewater System and the EPA regulation requirement that there be in place an implementation schedule for the sewer use charges.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 83-78 be amended to include the following section:

"BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that user charge fees will be implemented for all users on the system upon completion of the North Fork interceptor as bid and delineated in ADHS Approval to Award."

The foregoing resolution was on June 09, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
