

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation has requested a Right-of-Way in order that they may replace the McCoy Bridge on State Route 473 (Hawley Lake Road), and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the present bridge should be replaced, and

WHEREAS, on August 4, 1967, the White Mountain Apache Tribe entered into an Agreement with the Arizona Highway Department whereby the State accepted the Hawley Lake Road into the State Highway System and would provide improvements and maintenance on this road, and

WHEREAS, in this Agreement, the Tribe agreed to provide earthen materials without cost to the State for any future construction, reconstruction or realignment and would grant the State a Right-of-Way without cost on its present or any future construction, reconstruction or realignment of the Hawley Lake Road.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Arizona Department of Transportation is hereby granted a Right-of-Way 200 feet in width by 871.48 feet in length on the easterly line and 601.54 feet in length on the westerly line, comprising approximately .46 acre, as delineated on the map of definite location No. D-1-T-264 dated 4/29/83, which is on file in the Office of the Superintendent, Fort Apache Indian Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all costs and fees for materials and damages be waived in accordance with the Agreement entered into with the Arizona State Highway Department on August 4, 1967.


