## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TIRBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Governing Body, of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to recontract for the fiscal year 1984 and each year thereafter for the Higher Education Grant, Johnson O'Malley Supplemental Funds, Adult Vocational Training Grant, and Adult Education Grant of the Bureau of the Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, the P.L. 93-638 Education Program contracts has, in the past, been handled successfully, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council authorized the Tribal Education Director to develop, plan, negotiate, execute and administer the contracts and/or any amendments, and

WHEREAS, the authority granted under this resolution to the Tribal Education Director is to run concurrent with the term of the contract October 1, 1983 to September 30, 1984 and each succeeding year thereafter.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign the negotiated Education Contracts for fiscal year 1984 for the following programs:

> Higher Education Johnson O'Mallev

Adult Vocational Training Adult Education (GED)
