

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has passed the Towing Ordinance No. 130, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to define several terms of art within the language of the Ordinance.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ordinance No. 130 enacted on May 04, 1983 regarding the towing of abandoned vehicles on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, be and is hereby amended as follows:

(1) Insert: Section II: Definitions:


1. abandoned vehicles: any motor vehicle left without supervision on a tribal roadway for a period greater than forty-eight (48) hours.
2. disabled vehicle: any motor vehicle which is currently inoperable because it has malfunctioned.
3. roadways: any public road, street, highway, freeway, or other area designated and ordinarily used for vehicular travel; and located within the boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
4. unattended vehicle: any motor vehicle which is operable and is clearly in use but has been temporarily left unsupervised.

(2) Renumber from sections II et seq. appropriately.

(3) Delete the words "highway" and "freeway" from all sections except Section II: Definitions, and replace words with the word "roadway".

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

PROPOSED ORDINANCE OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE

BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ordinance No. 130 enacted on May 04, 1983 regarding the towing of abandoned vehicles on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, be and is hereby amended as follows:

- (1) Insert: Section II: Definitions:
